

THE NELL GOFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ST.CROIX DISTRICT OF THE GARDEN CLUB FEDERATION OF MAINE

PURPOSE: To encourage and financially aid students who are interested in a future major or who are currently majoring in horticulture, floriculture, landscape design, conservation, forestry, botany, agronomy, plant pathology, environmental control, city planning, or other gardening related fields.

QUALIFICATIONS: To qualify one must have successfully completed the second year of college/university study and have a declared major in areas related to those denoted above under "Purpose." Priority is given to a resident of the St. Croix District (Hancock County and the southern part of Washington County). **College sophomores** are eligible, as they will be entering their junior year the following fall.

Graduate students must be enrolled for the fall semester following the award. If awaiting acceptance to graduate school, notify the chairman of acceptance by April 25th of any given year to be considered, with all other materials previously **POSTMARKED** by the March 1st deadline.

The Scholarship Chairman must receive the application form, personal letter by applicant, letters of reference, grade transcripts, and list of activities required in the application form in a complete mailed package which is **POSTMARKED** no later than MARCH 1st of any given year.

The winner will be notified no later than May 1st, and will be **invited** to attend the annual spring meeting of the St. Croix District of the GCFM to receive the award.

THE NELL GOFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO COLLEGE JUNIORS,
SENIORS, OR GRADUATE STUDENTS WHO ARE LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE STATE
OF MAINE.

THE AWARD IS \$1,000.

The Scholarship Chairman must receive the following *complete package* of items POSTMARKED by the date MARCH 1st of any given year:

1. Application form,
2. Statement of occupational objective,
3. Brief statement of financial need,
4. Personal letter by applicant requesting this scholarship,
5. Official grade transcript,
6. 3 letters of recommendation as described above.

THE APPLICATION FORM MUST BE TYPED OR COMPUTER GENERATED.

ALL APPLICATIONS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

1. Aptitude in the field of horticulture
2. Academic record
3. Vocational interests and vocational potential
4. Character
5. Financial need
