OVERVIEW

The Peter H. Dolliver Legacy Scholarship of five hundred dollars is to be awarded annually to an applicant residing in Maine who best describes or illustrates:

- a desire to work in or study plant science, horticulture or closely allied fields;
- a goal of self-improvement of working skills and/or knowledge of horticulture-related activity with an emphasis on sustainable practices; and
- a demonstrated financial need through which this scholarship will support specified goals of study, research or innovative work practice.

The scholarship is open to applicants from all backgrounds having graduated from either home school or a high school in Maine. Preference will be given to graduate/residents of Mount Desert Island, Maine.

This scholarship is non-renewable in that it is a single year funding. Awardees may re-apply for another award with a new application in successive years.

TO APPLY:

Contact the Bar Harbor Garden Club, Scholarship Chair and obtain the process for the following:

- describe your studies, your future plans, your idea for a work practice innovation or project you have ongoing which are related to the field of plant science;
- provide a recommendation from a sponsor who has observed your study, your work or reviewed your plans for innovation; and
- respond to the following questions:
 - What have you done or experienced in your life journey to this point?
 - With whom have you worked?
 - What things interest you or stimulate curiosity in your thinking?
 - What are you excited to explore or develop with the aid of this funding?
 - What do you wish to accomplish and what goals have you set to get you there?
 - If awarded this scholarship, how will you use the funds?

If you are chosen for the Peter H. Dolliver Legacy Scholarship, you must appear before the Bar Harbor Garden Club Scholarship Committee to receive final consideration and award of certificate. Time and place will be determined jointly by candidate and Scholarship Chair.
